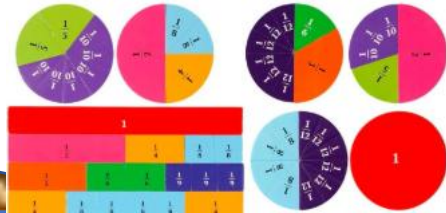
Our text this term is 'The Iron Man'. We shall use this novel to create our own narratives using descriptive language and carefully chosen vocabulary.

Science
