		<p>Children will know that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Old Testament tells the story of a particular group of people, the children of Israel known as the People of God — and their relationship with God.</li><li>• The People of God try to live in the way God wants, following his commands and worshipping him.</li><li>• They believe he promises to stay with them and Bible stories show how God keeps his promises.</li></ul>

			<p>Children will know that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Old Testament pieces together the story of the People of God.</li><li>• The story of Moses and the Exodus shows how God rescued his people from slavery in Egypt; Christians see this story as looking forward to how Jesus' death and resurrection also rescue people from slavery to sin</li><li>• Christians apply this idea to living today by trying to serve God and to bring freedom to others; for example, loving</li></ul>	

others, caring for them, bringing health, food, justice, and telling the story of Jesus.
