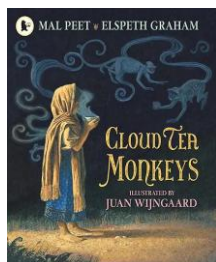
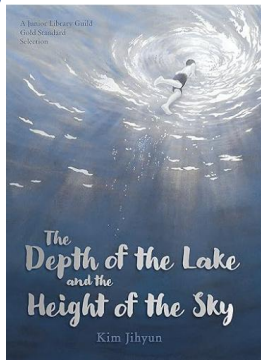


## English

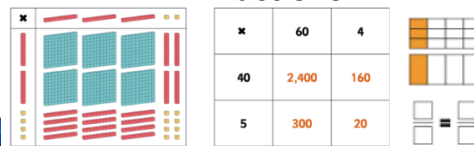
Our text this term is 'The depth of the lake and the height of the sky'. We shall use this picture book to create our own narratives using descriptive language.



We will also be exploring the text 'Cloud Tea Monkeys' and will be writing persuasive letters.

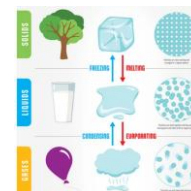
## Maths

As mathematicians this term, we shall continue to practise our multiplication and division skills using manipulatives and moving onto more formal written methods. We will then explore fractions.



## Science
